Sub	JVD Schemes – System generated notices to students identified tentatively as ineligible – Request to serve them to the students or their parents/family members-Regarding.

You are aware that the applications filed by the college in jnanabhumi login on behalf of the students are verified for their eligibility at two levels

- 1) In the village/ward secretariat to verify the details in application like address, contact number, bank account details, income related criteria, etc.
- 2) At the state level for the six conditions prescribed in G.O Ms.115, with reference to various data bases existing on those conditions.

Few students are yet to approach their concerned village/ward secretariat (in person or through their parent) to give the required data for verification of their eligibility. Such students are treated as prima facie ineligible. Such students are sent SMS twice in the last 10 days and their pendency is also displayed in the home page of the logins of colleges. Still they are yet to complete the verification of their application. They are required to immediately approach their Welfare and Education Assistant (WEA) in case they reside in village or the Ward Education and Data Processing Secretary (WEDPS) in case they reside in urban area within next five days and cooperate in confirming their application as eligible. Otherwise, they will lose the opportunity to claim the benefits of JVD schemes hereafter.

Secondly, few applications verified at both levels - i.e secretariat and state are found to be ineligible for the reason displayed in their status. However, due to possible errors in databases, an eligible student may be categorized as ineligible in system verification. Government desired that no eligible student is deprived of the scheme benefit on account of such errors. Hence, these students are given an opportunity to file objection before the concerned WEA or WEDPS on or before Feb 21, 2022 along with required evidences against their ineligibility, so that the objections can be verified and disposed of based on merits of the case by the MPDO/Municipal Commissioner concerned.

Hence, all the WEAs and WEDPSs are requested to download the system generated notices from their login in navasakam and serve them to the students concerned or their parent/family member, in next two days and take signature as evidence of serving of the notice and upload the same in the login. It is also requested to guide such students on the next course of action, in case they are actually eligible, but kept in ineligible list, as mentioned above, so that such students are not deprived of their legitimate right to get benefit of the fee/maintenance charges to be released by the Hon'ble CM in the month of March 2022.

This may be done in case of those students whose families fall under the jurisdiction of the village/ward secretariat. For remaining students, who are not known to the WEA/WEDPS in whose login they are displayed, a service will be given shortly for mentioning that they do not belong to their secretariat.
