Notification No.07/DM&HO/YSR KDP/2022-23 Dated. 14 .11.2022

Filling up the Post of Specialist Doctors (General Medicine and Paediatrics) and Medical Officers to work in the Tele medicine Hubs and SNCU's in YSR District. Applications called for from the eligible candidates from 15 .11.2022 to 20.11.2022 .

The Director of Health and Family Welfare & Mission Director, NHM, Govt. of A.P., Vijayawada, has issued instructions to fill up all the vacancies of Specialist Doctors and Medical officers in Telemedicine Hub and SNCU's.

Hence, applications are called for from the eligible candidates for the following category of Specialist Doctors and Medical Officers to work in Telemedicine Hub, Kadapa and Proddatur and SNCU, Proddatur on contract basis initially for a period of one year only. The remuneration will be paid @ Rs.1,00,000/- p.m. for Specialist Doctor and @ Rs 53000/- p.m for MBBS Doctor .

02.AGE:

As per the orders issued by the Government in G.O.Ms No.52 GAD(Ser.A) Dept., Dated.17.06.2020 the Maximum upper age limit as on 01.07.2022 shall be followed as below.

03. SELECTION CRITERIA:-

- a) 75% aggregate of marks obtained in all the years in the qualifying examination.

FOR THE POST OF MEDICAL OFFICER:-

- (i) In case of the candidates, who have been studied MBBS degree at the foreign universities and the marks awarded by them in the grading pattern, the aggregate of 75% marks will considered as follows;

- (ii) In case of the candidates, who have been studied MBBS degree at the foreign universities and the marks awarded by them in the percentage pattern, the aggregate of 75% marks will considered as follows;

- (iii) In certain foreign universities degrees marks shown as academic hours / amount of hours / ECIS Ranks / National Grade / Study hours / Credits / Grade points in GPA / Pass and such cases, where marks are not clearly shown, will be considered as 'C' Grade and the aggregate of 75% marks on merit will calculated as 50% / 100 X 75 = 37.50%.

- (iv) Marks awarded for languages will not be considered.

- b) 15% as weightage for experience who are working on outsourcing / contract basis in various Government schemes and any PPP projects in Health, Medical & Family Welfare Department who were appointed on contract / outsourcing basis through the District Selection Committee or selection process as applicable to the project.

BASED ON WORKING AREA :

- (i) @ 2.5 marks per six months in Tribal area.
(ii) @ 2.00 marks per six months in Rural area.
(iii) @ 1.00 marks per six months in Urban areas.

BASED ON COVID DUTIES :-

- (i) @ 5 marks per six months
(ii) @ 10 marks per one year
(ii) @ 15 marks per one year six months.

NOTE :- The above COVID-19 weightage shall be applicable only to the persons who have Appointed in the Special Recruitment for Covid on contract / Outsourcing / Honorarium basis and are appointed by the District Collector or any other competent authority bas on orders issued by the Government from time to time

Eligible service for consideration as service weightage is as follows;

- (i) Appointed in the posts having finance department concurrence and presently working or the services discontinued without the fault of the individual.
 - (ii) Appointed in the posts, which are not having finance department concurrence, but are presently working in APSACS, RNTCP, Mobile Epidemics, MCH Team in Tribal and vulnerable areas under NHM.
 - (iii) Appointed through the DSC and drawing salaries under 310/311
 - (iv) Appointed in the ESI Hospitals under Directorate of Insurance Medical Services through DSC and drawing salaries under 300-OCS grants
 - (v) Services in Dr. YSR Aarogya Sri Health Care Trust.
 - (vi) Services in 104 (Mobile Medical Units).
 - (vii) Services in UPHCs.
- c) 10% as weightage for the seniority to which the candidate is waiting for his/her recruitment in Government after completion of requisite qualification. Maximum 10 marks @ 1 mark per completed year after acquiring requisite qualification as on the date of notification.

04. Caste & Community:

- a. Community Certificate issued by the competent authority in terms of G.O.Ms.No.58, SW(J) Department, dt.12-05-1997 (Candidates belonging to BC, SC & ST of other States are not entitled for reservations).
- b. The General Rule 22 of Special representation shall apply to the appointments of these posts subject to various provisions in the relevant Service rules, except in the case of Physically Handicapped persons.

The reservation to Women will apply as per General Rule 22-A (G.O.Ms.No.41, WD&CW (Estt.) Department, dt.01-08-1996 and as per the G.O.No.63 GAD (Ser.D) Dept Dated. 17.04.2018.

05. The Rule of Reservation to local candidates is applicable:

Zonal/Local : In terms of Para 8 of the G.O., A.P. Public Employment (Organization of local cadres) and regularization of Director Recruitment order 1975 (G.O.Ms.No. 674; G.A.(SPF.A)DEPARTMENT, DT: 29-10-1975) G.O.P No.763;G.A.(SPF.A)Dept., dt:15/11/1975), read with G.O.Ms.No.124, G.A.(SPF.A) Department , dt; 7/3/2002.Reservation to the local candidates is applicable as provided in the Rules and as amended from time to time as in force on the date of notification. The candidates claiming reservation as local candidates should enclose the required study certificates (from IV class to SSC) or Residence Certificate as the case may be. Subsequent production of the certificates will not be entertained under any circumstances.

DEFINITION OF LOCAL CANDIDATE:

- i. "LOCAL CANDIDATE" means a candidate for direct recruitment to any a post in relation to that Local area where he/she has studied in Educational Institution(s) for not less than four consecutive academic years prior to and including the year in which he/she appeared for SSC or its equivalent examination. If however, he/she has not studied in any educational Institution during the above four years period, it is enough if he/she has resided in that area which is claimed as his/her local area during the above said period.

- ii. In case the candidate does not fall within the scope of the above, it will be considered if he/she has studied for a period of not less than seven years prior to and inclusive of the year in which he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years and where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal such local area where he/she has studied last (in such local areas) will be taken for determination of the local candidature. Similarly, if he/she has not studied during the above said period in any Educational Institution(s) the place of residence during the above period will be taken into consideration and local candidature determined with reference to the maximum period of residence or in the case of equal period where he/she resided last.
- iii. If the claim for local candidature is based on study, the candidate is required to produce a certificate from the Educational Institution(s) where he/she has studied during the said 4/7 years period. If, however, it is based on residence, a certificate should be submitted which is obtained from an Officer of the Revenue Department not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer, in independent charge of a Mandal.
- iv. If, however, a candidate has resided in more than one Mandal during the relevant four/seven years period but within the same District or Zone as the case may be separate Certificate from the Mandal Revenue Officers, exercising jurisdiction have to be obtained in respect of different areas.

NOTE: A Single certificate, whether of study or residence would suffice for enabling the candidate to apply a "LOCAL CANDIDATE".

A. Residence certificate will not be accepted, if a candidate has studied in any Educational institutions up to S.S.C. or equivalent examination, such candidates have to produce study certificates invariably.

B. The candidates claiming reservation as Local candidates should enclose the required certificates issued by the concerned authorities. Subsequent production of the certificate will NOT be entertained under any circumstances.

C. This local reservation is only for providing District representation.

6. All are informed that the various conditions and criterion prescribed herein are Governed by the General rules of A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 read with the relevant specific rules applicable to any particular service in the Departments, any guidelines or clarification is based on the said rules, and in case of any necessity, any matter will be processed as per the relevant general and special rules, cited as in force.
7. The above appointments are purely temporary and contract basis under NHM.
8. The selected and appointed candidates should stay at their bonafide Headquarters only.
9. Selected and appointed candidates are barred from doing private Practice.
10. Selected candidates shall be liable to serve in any part of the District.

11. FEE:

DEBARMENT

1. Candidates should make sure of their eligibility to the post applied for and that the declaration made by them in the format of application regarding their eligibility in all respects. Any candidate furnishing in-correct information or making false declaration regarding his/her eligibility at any stage or suppressing any information is liable to be debarred from recruitment conducted by the department and summarily rejection of their candidature for this recruitment & future recruitments.
2. The department is vested with duty of conducting recruitment and selection as per rules duly maintaining utmost secrecy and confidentiality in this process and any attempt by any one causing or likely to cause breach of this duty in such manner or by such action as to violate or likely to violate the fair practices followed and ensured by the Department will be sufficient cause for rendering such questionable means ground for department.

DISTRICT SELECTION COMMITTEE DECISION TO BE FINAL

The decision of the District Selection Committee pertaining to the application and its acceptance or rejection as the case may be conduct of counseling and at all consequent stages culminating in the selection or otherwise of any candidate shall be final in all respects and binding on all concerned under the powers vested with it. The District Selection Committee also reserves its right and modify regarding time and conditions laid down in the notification for conducting the various stages upto selection duly intimating details thereof to all concerned as warranted by any unforeseen circumstances arising during the course of this process.
