2.	The prescribed qualifications and experience are only a minimum. The mere fact that a candidate meets the minimum eligibility criteria does not entitle him/her to being called for the interview. The University reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates called for interview on the basis of qualifications and/or experience higher than the minimum prescribed. Call letters to attend interview will be sent only to the short-listed candidates by email. No correspondence will be made with applicants who are not short-listed/called for interview.
	Except for the candidates shortlisted for the interview, no communication will be sent to the other applicants.
