The Samagra Shiksha, Department of School Education is inviting Online applications for the posts of P rincipal, Post Graduate Teacher (PGT), Contract Residential Teacher (CRT), Physical Education Teacher (PET) in type-III KGBVs, from the eligible **woman candidates** on contract basis for the academic year 2026-27 to teach in 352 type-III KGBVs located across the State except **East Godavari, Dr. B.R.A. Konaseema, West Godavari, Krishna and Guntur** districts.

This notification is subject to the outcome of the court cases pending before the Hon'ble High court of Andhra Pradesh.

**Selection Process:**

The Recruitment shall be through a selection process consisting of Merit basis and other criteria stipulated by the Government from time to time.

**All the selections will be made as the newly formed districts as a unit.** The details of the posts are as follows.

**Teaching posts** – Interested and eligible **woman candidates** only can apply through online <http://kgbvrecruitment.apcfss.in> as per the schedule given in the notification.

### 3. Age Limit:

The candidate should have completed 18 years of age and should not cross 45 years of age as on 01-07-2025. However, in case of SC/ST/BC/EWS candidates the maximum age limit shall be 50 years and in case of differently

abled candidates the maximum age limit shall be 52 years. For Ex-service women the maximum age limit is 45 years.

#### **4. TET Qualification:**

**The candidates must pass Teacher Eligibility Test.**

- The candidates should be qualified in the AP Teacher Eligibility Test – APTET for the posts of Principals, CRTs (all subjects), PGTs (Only general subjects).
- TET qualification is not required for the posts of Physical Education Teacher and PGTs (Vocational subjects).

#### **5. Educational Qualifications:**

Must possess any Post-Graduate Degree from UGC recognized University with minimum 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/Differently abled persons.

And

Must possess B.Ed./M.A education from NCTE/UGC recognized Universities with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/Differently abled persons.

##### **II. Post Graduate Teachers:**

**Professional Qualifications:** Must possess B.Ed qualification from the universities recognized by NCTE (or) equivalent degree with Methodology in the concerned subject from UGC recognized University with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/ Differently abled persons.

##### **Academic Qualifications:**

Must possess two-year Post Graduate Course from the Regional Institute of Education of NCERT or Master's Degree from UGC

recognized university with minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/Differently abled persons in the relevant subjects as specified as under:

1. **PGT(English)** -Post graduation in English
2. **PGT (History)** – M.A in History
3. **PGT (Civics)**- Post graduation in Political Science/Public Administration.
4. **PGT(Commerce)**- Post graduation in Commerce with Accountancy/Cost Accounting/Financial Accountancy as a main subject/ Master of Financial Analysis provided having B.Com in Graduation level.  
**Note:** Post Graduates of M.Com in Applied/ Business Economics are not eligible for the post of PGT-Commerce.
5. **PGT (Economics)**- M.A., in Economics/ Applied Economics/Business Economics/Rural Development/ Mathematical Economics/ Econometrics.
6. **PGT (Maths)**- M.A.,/ M.Sc., in Mathematics/ Applied Mathematics/ Statistics/ Applied Statistics/ M.Sc., with Pure Mathematics/ M.Sc., Maths & Computer Science/ Advanced Operational Maths and must study mathematics as a subject at graduation level.
7. **PGT (Physics)** – M.Sc., in Physics/Electronics/ Applied Physics/ Nuclear Physics/ M.Sc (Tech) Engineering Physics with any specialization /M.Sc., (Tech) Instrumentation/Space Physics/M.Sc. Technical Engineering Physics/ M.Sc. (Tech) Engineering Physics/ M.Sc.(Tech) Applied Electronics/ M.Sc. (Tech) Electronics / M.Sc. Engineering Physics and instrumentation /Meteorology & Oceanography/ M.Sc (Tech) Co-Physics/ M.Sc (Astro Physics)/Any Physics based M.Sc Course of any UGC recognized University.

#### **13. PGT (Pre-School Teacher Training) (PSTT):**

Must possess M.Sc (Home Science) with specialization in child psychology and Human Development and Family Studies in recognized university affiliated to UGC .

(or)

Must possess B.Sc (Home Science) with P.G diploma in Child Development in recognized university affiliated to UGC .

(or)

Must possess B.Sc (Home Science) with P.G diploma in Early Child Education in recognized university affiliated to UGC .

(or)

Must possess M.A Child Care and Education in recognized university affiliated to UGC.

(or)

Must possess M.Sc (Psychology) can be considered provided they have done school psychology/ child psychology as one of the subjects in PG.

**14. PGT (Medical Lab Technician) (MLT):**

Must possess MBBS/BHMA/BAMS/B. pharmacy in recognized university affiliated to UGC

(or)

Must possess M.Sc (Micro Biology)/ M.Sc (Bio-Chemistry) or an equivalent Qualification in recognized university affiliated to UGC.

**15. PGT (Multi-Purpose Health Worker) (MPHW):**

Must possess B.Sc (Nursing) of 4 years duration in recognized university affiliated to UGC .

**16. PGT (General Foundation Course) (GFC):**

- i. MA Rural Development with not less than 50% of marks with 2<sup>nd</sup> class from recognized university.
- ii. If candidates with above qualifications are not available MA Economics with Agricultural Economics and MA with applied Economics may be preferred with not less than 50% of marks with 2<sup>nd</sup> class from recognized university.
- iii. If candidate with above qualifications is not available, candidates with MA Economics may be considered with not less than 50% of marks with 2<sup>nd</sup> class from recognized university.

**III. Contract Residential Teachers (CRT):**

**Academic and Professional Qualifications:**

Must possess four year integrated degree course from the Regional Institute of Education of NCERT with at least 50% marks in aggregate or Second Class Bachelor's Degree from the UGC recognized University with minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs, 45% for BCs, 40% for SC/ST and differently abled persons in the concerned subject(s) in

aggregate including electives and Languages in the combination of subjects specified.

**And**

Must possess B.Ed qualification from the universities recognized by NCTE (or) equivalent degree with methodology in the concerned subject with minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs, 45% for BCs, 40% for SC/ST and Differently abled persons in the concerned subject(s) and in case of CRT-Telugu and Hindi, Pandit Training from a recognized institution as specified under.

**1. Contract Residential Teacher (Telugu):**

A Bachelor's Degree with Telugu as the main subject (or) one of the three equal optional subjects / Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language in Telugu (B.O.L) (or) its Equivalent / a post Graduate Degree in Telugu with minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ ST/ Differently abled persons.

**2. Contract Residential Teacher (Hindi):**

A Bachelor's degree with Hindi as one of the full elective subject/ Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language in Hindi (B.O.L) / Praveena of Dakshina Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha / Vidwan of Hindi Prachara Sabha, Hyderabad/ any other equivalent recognized qualification in Hindi (BA degree Standard)/ Post Graduate Degree in Hindi with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/Differently abled persons.

Must possess any one of the following training qualifications.

### 3. Contract Residential Teacher (English)–

A Bachelor's Degree with English as the main subject (or) one of the optional subjects/ a Post Graduate Degree in English with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ ST/ Differently abled persons.

**And**

B.Ed., with English as a methodology subject with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST and Differently abled persons.

### 4. Contract Residential Teacher (Mathematics) –

A Bachelor's Degree with Mathematics/ Applied Mathematics/ Statistics as the main subject (or) one of the three equal optional Subjects with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST and Differently abled persons.

**And**

B.Ed with Mathematics as methodology subject with at least 50% of marks

in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST and Differently abled persons.

#### **5. Contract Residential Teacher (Physical Science)–**

A Bachelor's Degree with at least two of the following subjects as optional subjects or one as the main subject and other as subsidiary/ ancillary subjects Physics / Applied Physics / Engineering Physics & Instrumentation and Chemistry / Applied Chemistry / Industrial Chemistry / Pharmaceutical Chemistry / Medicinal Chemistry / Bio- Chemistry /Geology/ either Physics or its allied subjects/ Chemistry or its allied subjects with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST and Differently abled persons.

**And**

B.Ed with Physical Science/ Physics/ Chemistry/ Science as a methodology subject and should have studied Physics and Chemistry at Intermediate level with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST and Differently abled persons.

#### **6. Contract Residential Teacher (Biological Science)–**

A Bachelor's Degree with Botany and Zoology as optional subjects or one of the two as main and the other as subsidiary subject with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/Differently abled persons.

**Or**

A Bachelor's Degree with any two of the following subjects as optional subjects or one as the main subject and other as subsidiary/ ancillary subject:

Public Health / Human Genetics / Genetics / Bio-Chemistry / Environment Science / Micro-Biology /Bio-Technology/ Industrial Micro- biology/ Agriculture/ Food Technology/ Fisheries/ Nutrition/ Geology/ Sericulture/ Horticulture/ Forestry/ Poultry with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST and Differently abled persons.

**And**

B.Ed Degree with Biological Science/ Natural Sciences/ Science/ Botany/ Zoology as a methodology subject with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST and Differently abled persons.

**Note:** Regarding academic qualifications, a Candidate who studied one subject at Degree level and the second subject at Post Graduation level is also eligible to apply.

### **7. Contract Residential Teacher (Social Studies):**

A Bachelor's Degree with any two of the following subjects as optional subjects (or) one of them as a main and any other one as a subsidiary subject with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/Differently abled persons.:

History / Economics / Geography / Political Science / Public Administration / Sociology / Social Anthropology / Ancient Indian History Culture & Archaeology / Anthropology/ Social Work/ Philosophy/ Psychology.

**OR**

B.Com. with any four of the following subjects:

Commerce / Economics or Business Economics / Business Organization and Management/Statistics or Business Statistics or Quantitative Techniques/ Financial Services or Banking and Insurance /Accountancy or Financial Accounting/ Fundamentals of information Technology/Computers with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/Differently abled persons.

**And**

B.Ed. Degree with Social Studies / Social Sciences / Geography / History / Politics / Political Science/ Economics as a methodology subject with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs; 45% for BCs; 40% for SC/ST/Differently abled persons.

### **8. Physical Education Teacher (PET) QUALIFICATIONS**

Must possess Intermediate course from the Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh (or) Equivalent course recognized by Board of Intermediate Education, Govt.of A.P., with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs,45% for BCs, 40% for SC/ST.

**OR**

Bachelors Degree from UGC recognized University with at least 50% of marks in aggregate with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs, 45% for BCs and EWS,40% for SC/ST

**And**

Must Possess Undergraduate Diploma in Physical Education (U.G.D. P.Ed) recognized by NCTE or B.P.Ed/ M.P.Ed recognized by NCTE with at least 50% of marks in aggregate for OCs, 45% for BCs and EWS,40% for SC/ST

**Note: Differently abled persons are not eligible for the post of PET.**

**e. Medium of Instruction:**

English is the medium of instruction in all KGBVs. However, the candidates who pursued their studies in both English, Telugu Medium are also eligible to apply as per their educational qualifications to the posts concerned.

**Note: The candidate should study English as one of the subject up to graduation level**

**6. Selection Procedure:**

All selections shall be made purely on merit basis duly awarding certain weightage marks for the academic performance of the candidates in both academic and professional qualifications.

The merit in both academic and professional qualifications for the posts of Principal, CRT, PGT and PET shall be calculated for 100 marks as detailed below.

**7. (a) Merit calculation for the post of Principal and PGTs:**

### Calculation of weightage / Merit

- If a candidate secured 450 marks out of 600 in SSC Exams, then the weightage shall be calculated as  $450/600 \times 20 = 15$  marks
- As well as the secured marks in Intermediate is 755, out of 1000, then the weightage shall be calculated as  $755/1000 \times 10 = 7.55$
- For degree, if the secured marks is 825, out of 1000, then the weightage shall be calculated as  $825/1000 \times 20 = 16.5$
- For PG, if the secured mark is 800, out of 1000, then the weightage shall be calculated as  $800/1000 \times 30 = 24.00$
- For B.Ed. if the secured mark is 875, out of 1000, then the weightage shall be calculated as  $875/1000 \times 20 = 17.5$

**Note:** If any Board/ College/ University has issued their degree's in grade point system/ CGPA then the grades of the individual shall be converted into percentage as explained here under:

Formula – Achieved CGPA X 9.5

- For example, if a candidate achieved 9.0 CGPA points in her SSC /Intermediate / Degree / PG then her percentage is  $9.00 \times 9.5 = 85.5\%$ .
- In this case the total secured marks achieved by the individual in a 100 % scale is 85.05.

**Preparation of Merit List:**

For the purpose of deciding the merit / rank of candidates with equal marks, the following procedure shall be followed in that order:

i) Date of Birth: The elder candidate will be given higher rank over a younger candidate.

ii) If two or more female candidates have same date of birth, then candidates belonging to the following communities (in that order) shall be given a higher rank:

1. ST
2. SC (Group-I, II & III)
3. BC (A)
4. BC (B)
5. BC (C)
6. BC (D)
7. BC (E) and
8. OC

**8. District Level Selection Committee:**

A committee under the Chairmanship of the Collector is constituted at district level shall take up the initiation for recruitment in their respective districts as per the guidelines issued by the State Project Director, SS, A.P., The committee comprising the following members:

### **9. The Rule of Reservation:**

The rule of reservation as prescribed in the A. P. State Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 laid under rule 22 and revised orders issued in G.O Ms No. 77 dated 2.8.2023 of General Administration Department and G.O. Ms. No. 7, Social Welfare (CV) Department, dated 18.04.2025 shall be followed for every post and cadre.

#### **Note:**

1. Roster points for all posts will be arranged category wise, subject wise from the State office. All selections should be made as per the rosters arranged by the State office without any deviation.
2. Since all KGBVs are girls educational institutions, the rosters marked for general candidates should be filled with women candidates of that particular community.
3. All posts which are earmarked for community should be filled with the same community only. However, in case of non-availability of candidates in a particular community, then the following system shall be followed for filling of all posts.

**10. Special Guidelines for filling up of 100% posts in KGBVs:**

- a) If ST candidates are not available, then the same shall be filled with SC, if SC is also not available, then filled with BC- A, B, C, D, E candidates respectively, if BC candidates are also not available, then the same posts shall be filled with OC candidates.
- b) If SC candidates are not available, then the same shall be filled with ST, if ST is also not available, then filled with BC- A,B,C,D,E candidates respectively, if BC candidates are also not available, then the same posts shall be filled with OC candidates.
- c) In case of BC-A candidates are not available, then the same shall be filled with the other groups of BC ie.,B,C,D,E respectively and if the candidates are not available in the other group of BC, the then the same shall be filled SC, ST/OC respectively.
- d) In case of differently abled candidates PH/VH/HH if no candidate is available in particular sub-group of differently abled rosters, then the same will be filled other sub-groups among PH category. If no candidate is available in the PH subgroups, then they shall be filled with OC candidates.
- e) In case Ex-service women candidate is not available, then the posts can be filled with O.C. candidates.
- f) In regard to EWS, if no candidates are available then the posts are earmarked with EWS shall be filled with O.C. Candidates

**11. Role of District Level Committee:**

- a) In regard to the appointment of teaching posts i.e., Principals, PGTs, CRTs, PETs the district level committee is the competent authority to initiate the recruitment process in their respective districts.
- b) Verification of the merit lists furnished by the state office by constituting special committees is very much crucial in regard to preparation of final merit list.

- c) As the tentative merit lists generated by the **Commissioner of School Education** are not final because the marks and percentages entered by the candidates may not be correct and there is a possibility to enter more marks than the achieved marks intentionally or by mistake. Hence thorough verification of the certificates and confirmation is required on all the merit lists furnished by State office.
- d) It is the responsibility of the district level committee to prepare transparent merit lists for all posts at least 1: 20 ratio to each category of the posts to avert the ineligible candidates.
- e) Call for the shortlisted candidates for certificates verification well in advance at 1:3 ratio as per the schedule.
- f) Certificate verification includes r/o academic / professional qualifications, disability, caste etc.,
- g) Finalization of merit list and preparation of selection list, communication to the selected candidates.
- h) Issue of appointment orders to the selected candidates as per the schedule.
- i) Enter into Agreement with selected candidates as per the schedule.
- j) Furnish the list of selected candidates to the state office as per schedule.

## 13. Selection Units

Recruitment in KGBVs shall be made duly considering the new district as unit.

## **14. Ineligibility**

- a. The candidates who have worked in the KGBVs earlier and terminated on disciplinary grounds, misappropriation of funds, deviation of the legitimate duties are not eligible to apply.
- b. The Candidates who are not qualified in TET examination are not eligible.
- c. The candidates who are pursuing degree final year, post-graduation and B.Ed during the academic year 2025-26 are not eligible.
- d. The candidates who furnished wrong information intentionally, claiming higher marks than the achieved marks in academic and professional qualifications, hiding facts shall be viewed seriously and will be debarred permanently to apply all government jobs in future.
- e. The candidates who applied without proper local certificate are not eligible.

## **15. Contract conditions:**

- a. All the appointments issued under this notification is purely on contract/ outsourcing and temporary basis.
- b. The individuals do not have any right to seek regularization / Minimum Time Scale / Enhancement of honorarium.
- c. The performance of the individual will be measured based on their achievements, results, Lesson plans, dairy writing, and behavior with the students and staff.
- d. The appointing authority do have right to terminate the candidates with poor performance at any point of time without any prior notice.

## **16. Local status:**

- a) The candidates, who have studied 7 consequent years from classes 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> in a particular district shall be considered as local

candidate.

- b) If in case, one candidate studied 3 years in one district and 4 years in another district, the period in which district has studied 4 years shall be considered as local candidate of that particular district.
- c) In case of private candidates studied in un-recognized schools they have to furnish residence certificate issued by the Tahsildar of the concerned mandal duly specifying the period of residence from starting year to ending year prior to completion of SSC certificate.

### **17. Agreement:**

The Additional Project Coordinator, SS shall enter into an agreement with the candidates selected for teaching posts through the District Level Committee, with a clear mention that the appointments issued are temporary basis for the period of one academic year i.e.,2026-27 on Rs. 100/- Bond paper.

The State Project Director, Samagra Shiksha has all rights to complete the recruitment or cancel the recruitment at any point of time without giving any prior intimation to the individuals.

### **18. General Guidelines:**

- a) All the posts shall be filled up with female candidates only.
- b) No person shall be eligible for any post unless she is above 18 years and below 45 years of age as on 01.07.2025. However, in case of SC/ST/BC/EWS candidates the maximum age limit shall be 50 years and in case of physically challenged candidates the maximum age limit shall be 52 years and 45 years for Ex-service women.
- c) The physically challenged candidates, who have not less than 40% of disability in the relevant area as per the G.O.Ms.No.68, School Education (Exams) Department, dated: 26.10.2018, shall only be eligible for claiming age relaxation and rule of reservation.
- d) If any clarification is required with regard to the qualifications, except

PGT (Vocational), the G.O.Ms.No.68, School Education (Exams) Department, dated: 26.10.2018 shall be final. With regard to PGT (Vocational), the guidelines issued by the Board of Intermediate, AP RC. No. Voc. I – A1/ 471/ 2004 dated: 21.07.2006 shall be final.

- e) Since English is the medium of instruction in all KGBVs, the applicants should have capability to teach only in English Medium.
- f) However, even after selection, if found candidates performance is not upto the mark in teaching, submission of false documents, misbehavior with students, the services of such individual may be terminated at any time without prior notice in this regard.
- g) The district is the unit for applying and appointment for all cadres of posts.
- h) If two or more candidates have secured same marks in the merit, then the first priority will be given to the elder one. If date of birth is also same, then highest marks in graduation for CRTs, highest marks in post- graduation for Principals and PGTs and highest marks in Intermediate for PETs have to be considered.
- i) No candidate is allowed to apply in more than one district.
- j) The candidate who has interest in applying for these posts should upload all documents without fail. If any candidate failed to upload the relevant documents, her candidature summarily be rejected.
- k) The candidates who wish to claim EWS quota must furnish the income certificate below Rs. 8.00 Lakhs per annum issued by the competent authority.
- l) Applications without relevant documents summarily be rejected.
- m) Incomplete applications and offline applications will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- n) Applications received after due date will not be accepted.
