Ref:	 Instructions of the Hon'ble Chief Minister during the review meeting on implementation of SDGs on 31.10.2022. Feedforward meeting on Hon'ble CM's Review meeting on Localization of SDGs at VSWS level by the Chief Secretary on 02.11.2022 G.O.Ms.No. 132, General Administration (SC. A) Department, dated: 04.11.2022

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It is to inform that the Government is implementing various Welfare Schemes and Government Services and to all the eligible citizens and committed to achieve the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by the Year 2030.

In the reference 1st cited above, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has directed that the Line / Nodal Departments shall prepare an SOP for the following 8 Priority Indicators related to their Departments as a part of 'First Plan of Action' for the Government in order to achieve the ultimate goal of first rank in SDG index.

In the reference 3rd cited above, the Government has designated the GVWV&VSWS Department to prepare Volunteer HH Survey Questionnaire to conduct house to house survey for gathering and updating relevant data on these 8 priority SDG indicators. The survey is a regular process so that up to date data is available for implementation of activities taken for achieving the goal.

Volunteer House to House Survey for SDGs will be done in following steps:

- a. Volunteer Cluster Mapping App (Step 1): The volunteer house-to-house survey is an exercise to involve the people who were missed out in earlier enumeration. Using Volunteer cluster mapping app, any missing households and any new members in the existing households can be added. If anybody is missed out in this survey due to some technical or unforeseen reasons, they will be added in regular surveys which will be taken up every month as per Hon'ble CM instructions.
- b. DA/WEDPS GSWS login to transfer married women: Provision to apply for transfer option given at DA/WEDPS where the DA/WEDPS uploads the Marriage certificate along with eKYC of husband & wife. Once the application is approved by MPDO, the transfer of married women from one household to another household will happen.

DA/WEDPS and volunteers are expected to facilitate the applicant for filing the application for marriage certificate. The SLA period to issue marriage certificate is 15 days.

- c. Panchayat Secretary / Ward Administrative Secretary login in GSWS portal to add 0-5 age group children: For the new born between the age group of 0-5 years, through Shishu/Baal Aadhar, parents can apply at Panchayat Secretary login to update their child in household database.
- d. Volunteer SDG HH Survey (Consistent Rhythms Application) (Step 2) will be divided based on four cohorts.
 - 0-5 years age group
 - 6-17 years age group
 - 18-23 years age group

- Pregnant women with 15-49 years age group.
- e. Members of the HHs will be considered as per their date of birth(age) and gender mentioned in Aadhar and questions will appear based on different cohorts where these members lie as per age and gender. The Survey format will be enabled in **Consistent Rhythms App** for Volunteers.
- f. The above-mentioned exercise to include missing population in Household database duly using Volunteer Cluster Mapping App shall be done for three days from 9th to 11th November 2022. Training of the concerned secretariat functionaries (ANM, MSK, WEA/WWDS and DA/WEDPS) will be given by Education, Health and Women and Child Welfare departments by 11th November 2022 on the SDG Survey Questionnaire. The concerned VWS functionaries in coordination with FOA (Field Operation Agency) shall in turn impart training to the Volunteers from 12th November to 14th November 2022. The Volunteer SDG HH Survey shall begin immediately after training (14th November) and to be completed by 18th November 2022.

The District Collectors are requested to issue instructions to all the Municipal Commissioners and the MPDOS and shall complete the Cluster Mapping (Volunteers Cluster Mapping App) and SDGs HH Survey (Consistent Rhythms Application) through Volunteers as per timelines given above without fail.
