It is informed that, vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Aadhaar Enrolment Camps have been conducted at Swarna Gramam & Swarn Wardu Offices in the State from 9-03-26 to 13-03-2026 & 23-03-2026 to 26-03-2026. After completion of Aadhaar Enrolments up to March – 2026, a total of 12.09 lakhs have been identified as requiring Mandatory Biometric updates in Aadhaar in the state. In previous Aadhaar special camps 79000 MBUs were completed. The balance of 12.09 lakh MBUs are still pending.

In this connection, the continuation of the previous Aadhaar Special Camps up to March-2026, the SGSW Department has decided to conduct Aadhaar Special Camps from **15.04.2026 to 18.04.2026 & from 21.04.2026 to 24.04.2026** at Swarna Gramam & Swarna Wardu Offices, AWCs specially focus on pending Mandatory Biometric Updates of the students of Junior colleges who are in the ages group of 15 -17 years are required Mandatory Biometric Updates and also for New Enrolments /Other Aadhar Services.

In view of the above, all the Collector & District Magistrates in the state are requested to issue necessary instructions to the DSOs, DDOs, MSOs/USOs to conduct Aadhaar special camps at Swarna Gramam & Swarna Wardu Offices, AWCs from **15.04.2026 to 18.04.2026 & from 21.04.2026 to 24.04.2026** for updating MBUs of Students and the necessary list of Schools & Junior Colleges and line-lists of the said students are shared to DSOs of concern Districts. Further requested to issue necessary instructions to them for creating awareness on Aadhaar Special Camps to utilize for updating of Mandatory Biometrics and other Aadhar Services.

If any expenditure is incurred for mobilizing the Aadhaar Kits for attending and conducting Aadhaar Special Camps at other Swarna Gramam & Swarna Wardu Offices, AWCs an amount of Rs. 1,000/- towards mobilization charges will be released to the Aadhaar Operators (DAs/WEDPSs) and assistance support charges will be released to the Mahila Police as decided in the reference 2nd cited for the Aadhaar Special Camp period.

Further, all the Collector & District Magistrates in the state are requested not to depute the Digital Assistants / WDPSSs and the Mahila Police who are assigned for Aadhaar special camps to any other duties during these Aadhar Special Camp days.
