**GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION PROCESS IN TGMR SCHOOLS &
JR. COLLEGES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027**

NOTIFICATION

Online Applications are invited through TGMREIS Official website tgmreistelangana.cgg.gov.in from the eligible candidates from Minorities (Muslims, Christians, Parsis, Jains, Sikhs & Buddhists) Communities and Non-Minorities (SC, ST, BC, OC) for fresh admissions in class V in 205 TGMR Schools, Intermediate 1st Year in TMR Jr. Colleges (General & Vocational) and 18 COE TGMR Jr. Colleges of Telangana State and for backlog vacancies for Minorities (Muslims, Christians, Parsis, Jains, Sikhs & Buddhists) in classes VI, VII & VIII for the academic year 2026-2027. Offline application forms can also be obtained from the concerned Schools & Jr. colleges and submitted to the concerned Principals directly for online uploading. Priority will be given to TGMREIS Students for admission in Intermediate 1st Year in TGMR Jr. Colleges subject to their eligibility as per TGMREIS norms.

- **V Class:** For Minorities - First cum first basis
For Non-Minorities - By Lucky Dip
- **VI, VII & VIII classes** (backlog vacancies of minorities): First cum first basis
- **Intermediate (General & Vocational):** On merit based on GPA in SSC/10th class 2026.
- **Intermediate (COE TGMRJC):** Screening Test followed by Interview.

ADMISSION IN TGMR SCHOOLS

I. HOW TO SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION.

1. The eligible candidates can submit his/her application through online by visiting TGMREIS website **tgmreistelangana.cgg.gov.in** or through Mobile App in prescribed format from any internet centre or any TGMR Institution or Head Office, TGMREIS.
2. The submission process of online application will start from **16-01-2026** and the Last date for submission of online application is **28-02-2026**.
3. Offline application can also be obtained from any TGMR Institution and duly filled in application can be submitted to the concerned Principal directly for uploading the same to the TGMREIS website.
4. Before submission of ONLINE Application, the candidates should go through the prospectus and application format by visiting TGMREIS Official website **tgmreistelangana.cgg.gov.in**
5. While filling the application form the candidate should ensure that his/her name, date of birth, category (religion/caste), Class and Name of the school where he/she is seeking admission, gender, parent's phone number etc. are correctly filled. In order to avoid any mistakes before filling the online application, the candidates can fill a **sample application form given at Annexure- A** and after verifying the details, the online application can be filled and submitted.
6. Upload the Passport size photo and signature of the candidate within 100 Kb size only.
7. **Option of School for admission in Class V:** The candidate can opt any one TGMR School in his/her native erstwhile district for admission. Boys should opt boys TGMR School and Girls should opt girls TGMR School in his /her native Erstwhile District.
8. **Option of TGMR School for admission in Class VI, VII or VIII (Minorities Category only):** The candidate should opt any TGMR School in his/her native erstwhile district where the vacancies are available in Minorities category. Boys should opt boys TGMR School and Girls should opt girls TGMR School.

9. There is no ONLINE registration fee.
10. There is no scope for change of any particulars mentioned in the application after submission of ONLINE application.

The number of seats earmarked for Orphan / Disabled / Armed force personnel of Ex – Serviceman or widows of Ex – Servicemen children shall be allotted from the quota of respective community, if more number of candidates are registered from these categories against the allotted seats, admission shall be given as per the selection process. If no child is registered from these specialized categories, the seats shall be filled by giving the admission to the children of respective community as per the selection process.

IV. INFORMATION TO BE FURNISHED AT THE TIME OF ONLINE REGISTRATION BY THE CANDIDATES:

At the time of submission of ONLINE application the candidate should upload the passport size photograph and signature of the candidate and furnish the following information in the prescribed format.

- a) Name of the candidate and Mother & Father name.
- b) Mobile no. of Parents.
- c) Date of Birth.
- d) Aadhaar card number.
- e) Gender (Boy or Girl)
- f) Class in which he/she is seeking admission
- g) **Option of TGMR School for admission in class V**
- h) **Option of TGMR School for admission in class VI, VII & VIII (against backlog vacancies in Minorities category only)**
- i) Present study details like class, year of study (academic year), school name, location and address. Institution type (Govt. /Private Recognised by Govt.)
- j) Annual Income of parents.
- k) Information about Religion/Caste.
Minority category (Muslim/Christian/Jain/Parsis/Buddhist/Sikh),
Non-Minorities (SC/ST/BC/OC)
- l) Residential address.
- m) Information about Physical Disability, Orphan or son/daughter of Armed Personnel/Ex-servicemen/Widow of Ex-Servicemen if applicable.

VI. Criteria For Selection of Candidates For Admission in TGMR SCHOOLS:

Criteria for Selection of candidates for Minorities and Non-Minorities category is different.

A. Selection of MINORITIES Students:

1. Admission of candidates against the vacancies is based on First cum First served
i.e. Time & Date of submission of application subject to the eligibility as per TGMREIS norms and submission of all the documents like Aadhaar card, TC, Bonafide & Date of Birth certificate, Income certificate and Physical disability, orphan, children of ex-servicemen (if applicable) and Medically fit duly following the Reservation Matrix prescribed by the Society at the time of admission process.
2. All offline applications received shall be uploaded in the web portal by concerned DEO and register shall be maintained clearly mentioning the date & time of receipt of applications which is taken into consideration in the order of submission and it should be verified by the Principal and affix his/her signature on day to day basis.

3. The parents of the applicants shall be called in the order of date & time of submission of application i.e. First cum first served as per the vacancies available with submission of all the relevant certificates/documents as mentioned above to finalise the admission duly following the admission schedule. In this regard, the concerned Principal shall communicate well in advance (at least 10 to 15 days before) the date & time of admission to the Parents through phone call, SMS and any other means of communication.
4. The no. of parents of online candidates called for admission shall not be more than the no. of vacancies available in the respective category.
5. The Parents who report for admission of their wards will be given token numbers for verification of certificates and documents.
6. The Principal should constitute 2 to 3 committees for verification of documents.
7. The Committee shall verify the documents as per the checklist (Annexure-B) and write their remarks and send the parents to the Principal.
8. After the verification of documents, the original documents of the eligible candidates should be retained by the school and the Principal will issue confirmation letter for admission in prescribed format (Annexure-C) to the parents with a direction to bring their wards on reopening day to admit in the hostel.
9. The parents who failed to fulfil the eligibility criteria, the candidature of their wards will be cancelled for admission and the vacancies will be filled by calling the parents of the online candidates of the next order. This process will be continued till all the vacancies are filled.
10. The Parents who have attended for admission process but failed to submit the relevant documents to confirm the admission or the parents who have not responded to the phone calls or SMS to attend for admission of their ward on the scheduled date, their candidature can be kept in the waiting list. If any vacancies exist even after completion of admission process, these vacancies shall be filled from waiting list as per seniority or calling offline applications.
11. Parent/guardians shall submit the willingness letter to the Principal to join their wards as a boarder in TGMR Schools, since it is mandatory for the students to stay in the Hostel during the working days.
12. **Under any circumstances seats allotted to Minorities Category shall not be filled with Non-Minority candidates even if the candidates are not available from Minority community**

B. Selection of NON-MINORITIES Candidates:

1. Selection is done by drawl of lucky dip at school level in presence of Selection Committee & the Parents.
2. Selection Committee.
 - a) Convenor: Principal of respective TGMR School.
 - b) Member: School Coordinator
 - c) Member: One PGT of the respective School
 - d) Observer : DMWO/RLC may be invited as observer
3. Venue of Selection process: Respective TGMR School.

4. The list of the candidates enrolled through the online will be forwarded by the Head Office, TGMREIS to the respective schools after receipt of the same from CGG.
5. The selection shall be done Community/caste wise.
6. The Community/Caste wise list of enrolled candidates shall be displayed in the notice board of the school.
7. Parents of the enrolled candidates shall be informed about the selection process.
8. If the number of candidates enrolled from a particular community is less or equal to the number of seats/vacancies available, these candidates shall be selected directly for admission without drawl of lucky dips.
9. If the number of candidates enrolled from a particular community/caste for admission in a class is more than the number of seats/vacancies available in the respective category, the selection shall be done by drawl of lucky dips.
10. Tokens may be used for drawl of lots. The token number of the candidates should be same as that of the serial number of the candidates in the enrolment list.
11. Before the process of selection of the candidates, the principal shall explain the selection process, Rule of Reservation, number of candidates enrolled from each category/community, number of seats/vacancies available in each category/community etc. to the committee members and the parents at the time of selection process. The minutes of the meeting also shall be recorded.
12. Drawl of lucky dips shall be done Community/caste wise in the order SC, ST, BC and OC categories. The selection list should be prepared in the same manner based on the drawl of the lucky dips. Before putting the Token number into the box, the name of the candidates and token number shall be read in presence of committee members and the parents.
13. Community wise waiting list may be drawn from left over online applicants by lucky dip and prepare the list in priority order based on lucky dip, this list may be used to fill the vacancies if any after the operation of the Selection list.
14. At any point of time, the vacancies in Minority category (if available) shall not be filled up with the Non-Minority candidates even if the candidates are not enrolled from any Minority community without the permission of the Secretary.
15. After selection of the candidates by drawl of lucky dips, their selection shall be considered as provisional, accordingly list of provisionally selected candidates shall be prepared and displayed in the school notice board duly signed by the selection committee members.
16. The Principal concerned shall communicate to the parents of provisionally selected candidates through the SMS and phone call with a direction to report to the School with their ward along with the following documents in original and one set of photo copies of certificates for verification.
 - a) Bonafide certificate duly mentioning the Date of Birth issued by the School where the candidate has enrolled/studied during the academic year 2025-26.
 - b) Aadhaar card (photo copy).
 - c) Parents Annual Income Certificate issued by the Tahsildar.

- d) For SC, ST and BC candidates, caste certificate issued by Tahsildar
 - e) For disabled candidates medical certificate issued by the concerned Medical Board
 - f) For Armed force personnel/Ex- servicemen children – certificate obtained from concerned authorities.
 - g) Converted Christians – Certificate issued by the concerned authorities as mentioned below
 - i. For the persons of Scheduled castes converted to Christians & their progeny (BC-C) the community certificate issued by the Tahsildar.
 - ii. For all other persons converted to Christians either of the following proof shall be submitted.
 - The Transfer certificate/leaving certificate/Bonafide issued by respective schools wherein it is mentioned as Indian Christian/Roman Catholic/Anglo Indian.
 - The Baptism certificate issued by Church authorities to the student/Individual or if in case student does not have Baptism certificate then their Father/Mother/Guardian’s Baptism certificate.
 - h) Parent/guardians shall submit the willingness letter to the Principal to join their wards as a boarder.
17. After verification of the above certificates, if the candidate fulfils the eligibility criteria as per TGMREIS norms and medically fit, the Parents shall be issued a letter with a direction to submit the following to confirm admission.
- Record sheet/ T.C in original.
 - Two latest Passport size Photographs of candidates and one Photograph each of father, mother and guardian (if any) along with their postal address.
 - The guardian (if any) should produce an affidavit signed before the Notary about the Guardianship of the student.
18. After receipt of the above T.C./Record sheet from the eligible candidate, his/her admission shall be confirmed by issuing the admission letter along with the daily routine, rules and regulations of TGMR School with a direction to bring their ward to the School to join in the hostel on the Reopening day of the school after the Summer vocation.
19. If any vacancies are left over in any category for not having fulfilled the eligibility criteria or not responded to the communication for admission by the provisionally selected candidates of the selection list, the candidates from the waiting list shall be admitted duly following the rule of reservation and above procedure.
20. **Under any circumstances seats allotted to Minorities Category shall not be filled with Non-Minority candidates even if the candidates are not available from Minority community.**

- b) The process of submission of online application will start from 16-1-2026 and last date for online submission of application is 28-02-2026.
- c) Offline application forms can also be obtained from any TGMR Junior Colleges/Schools and duly filled in can be submitted to the concerned Principals directly for uploading the same to the TGMREIS website.
- d) Sample Application given at **Annexure-E** of the prospectus.
- e) Before submission of ONLINE Application the candidates should go through the prospectus cum application form by visiting TGMREIS Official website tgmreistelangana.cgg.gov.in
- f) Candidate should upload his/her passport size photograph and signature.
- g) **Option of Group:**
Any one group either from General course i.e. MPC, BiPC, CEC, MEC or HEC or from Vocational courses i.e. MLT, MPHW, ET, LM&DT, CS, CT, CGT, T&HM, A&T, ACP and CGA.

If more number of candidates are registered from these categories against the allotted seats, the admission shall be given based on the merit. If no candidate is registered from these specialized categories, the seats shall be filled by giving the admission to the candidates of respective community based on the merit.

VIII. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF CANDIDATES:

1. The selection of candidates shall be done on merit based on the GPA secured in SSC/X class Board **examination who have passed with minimum 6.0 GPA.**
2. If more than one candidate secured the same GPA, the selection shall be done based on the following criteria.

Note: If the Grade points in the subjects given above remains same, selection shall be done based on the D.O.B. i.e. Senior students shall be given preference

IX. ADMISSION PROCESS:

1. Admission process will start immediately after declaration of SSC Results of Telangana State.
2. **Priority to TGMREIS Students for admission: Priority shall be given to the TGMREIS students subject to their eligibility. After admission of TGMREIS Students, the left over vacancies shall be filled with Non-TGMREIS Students who have submitted their online applications against the vacancies available** duly following the Rule of reservation of TGMREIS.
Hence Admission of students shall be done in two stages
Stage I: Admission of TGMREIS students
Stage II: Admission of Non TGMREIS students.
3. **The number of students admitted in any group in the sanctioned stream need not be restricted to 40, i.e. each group can have over and above 40. However total number of students admitted in both the groups should not exceed the sanctioned strength of 80. Rule of reservation should be followed for the sanctioned strength of 80.(vide circular No.2274/C/TMREIS/2022, dated; 08-09-2022)**

A. Admission of TGMREIS students:

1. As per the nominal rolls, the concerned Principals of Jr. Colleges where the candidate opted for admission should collect the photo copies of SSC Memorandum of marks or Marks (GPA and Grade points in all the subjects) of students from the concerned Principals of TGMR Schools from where the students have passed SSC.
2. The Principal will prepare the merit list of eligible candidates as per the criteria given above and finalise the provisional selection list duly following the Rule of reservation of TGMREI Society.
3. The list of the provisional selection candidates shall be communicated to the concerned Principal of School from where the students have passed class Xth with a request to send their documents like TC, Bonafide certificate, Memorandum of Marks, Aadhaar Card, caste certificate (if applicable), etc. through a special messenger. **These documents should not be handed over to the students or their parents.**
4. After the receipt of the documents from the concerned Principal of school, the Principal of the Jr. College should communicate to the parents of students about confirmation of admission of their ward in the college with an instruction to bring their ward to the college on the reopening day with 02 latest size passport size photographs of student and one passport size photograph of each father, mother and guardian (if any) to admit their ward in the college for admission.
5. **After the process of admissions, if any vacancies are available the concern Principal of Jr. College shall communicate category wise vacancy position to all other Schools and Jr. Colleges to enable the concerned principals of schools/colleges to counsel the students who did not get admission in their opted colleges to take admission against the vacancies in these colleges.**

B. Selection of Non-TGMREIS students:

1. The process of admission of Non-TGMREIS students shall be started after the admission of all the TGMREIS students.
2. After the admission of TGMREIS students, the Principals of the colleges shall prepare the category wise vacancy position (if available).
3. Based on the vacancies, all the students of respective category who have submitted their online applications and opted the college shall be called for submission of following documents for verification.
Aadhaar card, Memorandum of marks of SSC Board 2026, TC, Bonafide, Income certificate of the parent, Caste certificate (if applicable), disabled/orphan/children of armed forces/ex-servicemen/widows of ex-servicemen (if applicable)
4. The Principal should constitute 2 to 3 committees for verification of documents.

5. The Committee shall verify the documents as per the checklist (Annexure-F) and prepare the merit list of the eligible candidates as per the selection criteria given above.
6. As per the merit list, the category wise provisional selection list of the candidates shall be prepared duly following the Rule of Reservation of TGMREIS.
7. The provisionally selected candidates shall be informed to submit the above documents in original with one set of set of photo copies.
8. Principal shall take an undertaking from the parent that his/her ward is medically fit.
9. After receipt of the above documents from the Provisionally selected candidates, his/her admission shall be confirmed by issuing the admission confirmation letter (Annexure-G) along with the daily routine, rules and regulations of TGMR Jr. colleges with a direction to report to the college on reopening day to join in the hostel to attend the regular classes.
10. Principal should also prepare the category wise waiting list as per the merit.
11. After operation of provisional selection list, if any vacancies are left over in any category, these vacancies shall be filled from the waiting list duly following rule of reservation and above criteria.
12. If any vacancies are left over in Muslim or Christian minority category even after process of admission from the waiting list, they should not be filled by any other community candidates.
13. If any vacancies are available in Sikh, Jain, Parsis or Buddhist even after process of admission from the waiting list then these vacancies shall be filled by the Muslim candidates based on the merit, after exhaust of Muslim candidates, the Christian candidate shall be considered for selection based on the merit.
14. **Under any circumstances seats allotted to Minorities Category shall not be filled with Non-Minority candidates even if the candidates are not available from Minority community.**
15. For claiming admission under disability category, the candidate should possess at least 40% impairment irrespective of the type of disability.

1. The eligible candidates can submit his/her application through online by visiting TGMREIS website **tgmreistelangana.cgg.gov.in** or through mobile app in prescribed format from any internet centre, any TGMR institution or Head Office, TGMREIS.
2. The process of submission of online application will start from 16-1-2026 and last date for online submission of application is 05-02-2026.
3. Offline application forms can also be obtained from any TGMR Junior Colleges/Schools and duly filled in can be submitted to the concerned Principals directly for uploading the same to the TGMREIS website.

5. Before submission of ONLINE Application the candidates should go through the prospectus cum application form by visiting TGMREIS Official website **tgmreistelangana.cgg.gov.in**
6. Candidate should upload his/her passport size photograph and signature.
7. The students are permitted to choose any one of the admission tests of the intensive integrated coaching classes offered to get admissions into TGMR Jr. colleges (COE).
8. No student is permitted to opt more than one intensive integrated coaching admission test.
9. Principals are instructed to explain briefly about various intensive integrated coaching classes offered in different COE Colleges to their students and motivate them to apply in which they are interested as per their aptitude.
10. COEs seats will be allotted to the candidates based on State wide merit duly following rule of reservation of TGMREIS.
11. Date & Time of screening test: 12-02-2026 from 10:30 am to 01:30 pm.
12. Screening Test Centre: Candidates can opt any one of the following screening test centres.

Selection Process for admission in TGMJRJC (COE) 2026

Selection process will be in two levels.

1. Preliminary round (Screening Test)
2. Technical round (Oral Interview)

1. PRELIMINARY ROUND (Screening Test)

The purpose of conducting Preliminary round is shortlisting the eligible candidates as per the norms and Cut off marks decided by the Secretary, TGMREIS.

Screening test will be conducted in the designated test centers.

Principal of the screening test (TGMR School) centers will act as Chief Superintendent of the Centre for conduct of the test.

Mode of conducting Screening Test:

1. Separate test paper is designed for each intensive integrated coaching classes i.e. IIT/JEE, NEET, CLAT and CA/CS Foundation.
2. Standard of the Question paper: Question paper is of SSC standard of the State Board, Government of Telangana.
3. About the Screening Test:
 - a. The test is conducted in Offline as Pen-Paper Test and Objective Type (MCQ).
 - b. Question paper consists of 120 questions and 120 marks, each question carries one mark.
 - c. Method of Recording of Answers: The test is OMR based, each question has 4 options of answers, out of which one is correct, the candidate has to choose the correct answer and darken the relevant circle in the OMR Sheet against the corresponding question number with blue/black ballpoint pen.
 - d. Medium of Question Paper: English.
 - e. There will be no negative marks for wrong answered questions or Unanswered questions and multiple answers will receive nil marks
4. Duration of the Test: 3 hours.

Before Examination Days

1. Principals are instructed to identify fully ventilated rooms for conducting admission test and make sure that all CC cameras are working properly in examination halls.
2. Seating arrangement plan must be designed through jumbling system by allotting the students opted with different coaching in a sequence.
3. Mark /paste Hall tickets numbers in examination halls a day before commencing the test.
4. Language teachers should be allotted for invigilation duties. Other teachers /staff will not be allowed to enter into the examination hall.
5. Mobile phones are not allowed in and outside of the examination halls.
6. Question paper and OMR sheet will be sent to TGMR Schools official mail through academic mail, Head office, TGMREIS. These papers and OMR sheets should be downloaded half an hour before in the presence of the Principal and RLC/Departmental officer under the surveillance of CC cameras.

Evaluation process of Entrance Test papers.

1. RLCs are informed to identify any one of the schools as erstwhile district level Nodal centre for evaluation purpose.
2. Once screening test is completed all the principals are instructed to pack Test Wise Written OMR Sheets separately along with the student's particulars i.e. Name of the student, Father Name, Community, Category, Aadhaar No, Contact no etc., and send it to Erstwhile district level nodal centre on the same day.
3. RLCs are informed to identify and invite PGTs/TGTs as evaluators to evaluate OMR Sheet at nodal centres. They have to be informed to report at nodal centre by 9:30 am.

4. Principal of the Nodal centre have to open the lock and sealed answered OMR sheets in the presence of RLCs.
5. No one is allowed to evaluation hall except the officials/staff involved in the process. Evaluators have to be informed to deposit their mobile phones to the principal of the nodal centre.
6. Once evaluation process has been completed, the principal of the nodal centre has to prepare award list and get signature of evaluators and send signed scanned copy along with soft Excel sheet to RLCs concerned. After verifying the award list by the Concerned RLCs, they should attest and send along with the soft copy in excel sheet to Incharge of COE email id tsrjclbnagar@gmail.com on the following day without fail.

2. TECHNICAL ROUND (Oral Interview)

1. All the short listed Students will be called for attending Technical round (oral interview) on the scheduled dates at selected TGMR Institutions campuses by making call/sending message to their registered mobile number.
2. Students will be informed time, date and venue well in advance to attend the oral interview.
3. Candidates have to attend the venue of TGMR Institutions on time either with escort teacher or parents. No TGMREIS student should be sent alone.
4. Principals of TGMR Institutions for Girls must take all precautionary measure while sending students for technical round by viewing their safety and security as per the Norms of TGMREIS
5. Candidates will be asked questions orally by a team of subject experts to assess, analyse and interpret their levels to get admission into COEs.
6. Candidates may be asked questions to know the reasons for choosing the particular coaching, previous knowledge about those courses and what they want to become in future.
7. Candidates who wish to take coaching for IIT/JEE & NEET may be asked to solve basic problems of mathematics and physical science during the technical round (Oral interview) by Subject experts.
8. Once Technical round is completed the final selected students list will be sent to all TGMR Institutions and communicated to the candidates. The entire process will be done as per the rule of reservation and norms of TGMREIS. The decision of the secretary, TGMREIS is the final in selecting students and allotting students in various TGMR Jr. college COEs.

Allotment of Hall Ticket numbers.

1. Hall ticket number bears Alpha code followed by 2 digit Erstwhile District code followed 2 digit test centre code and 4 digit number.
2.
